CLASS PLACEMENT: FINDING THE RIGHT FIT

At CSDS, we know how meaningful it is for a student to feel comfortable, confident, and safe in the classroom. Children's class placement is primarily determined by age. Youth & Teen class placement is guided by a combination of age, ability and experience while strongly considering each dancers' personal goals. If you have previous dance experience but are new to CSDS, we may recommend a placement class for evaluation. Studio Director, Miss Christina, has expertise in this field. Please seek her guidance to help you find the best class options!

CSDS SEASON 27: GETTING STARTED

Thank you for enrolling at Center Stage Dance Studio.

CSDS operates seasonally on a 33-week dance class & performance schedule. We offer quality, curriculum guided instruction through the Fall & Winter semesters where dancers will see progress & growth from week to week. We shift our focus to choreography & preparing for the annual recital performance during the final Spring semester.

Classes begin on Tuesday September 18, 2023

The full 33-week dance season is divided into 3 equal semester payments. Tuition is due at the start of each semester. See Page 7 for pricing details. CSDS can occasionally accommodate families who want to sign up for a single semester, however, we encourage you to register for the full season to see your hard work through to the end & experience the magic of performing on stage in the annual June recital.

- Fall Semester: September 18 to December 9 (11 weeks)
- Winter Semester: December 11 to March 16 (11 weeks)
- **Spring Semester:** March 18 to June 8 (11 weeks)
 - No more "Recital Semester": Starting now, all classroom-learning weeks are included in the 11-week semester price.
- RECITAL WEEK: June 8-15. Performance & Rehearsals announced by Dec. 1st.

Enrollment Fee:

All students registering for a new season of dance please complete the *online enrollment form* and submit a non-refundable registration fee of \$25 per family.

What does it cost to take dance lessons at CSDS?

Dance instruction that comes with performance opportunities also bring costs to families. Enrollment in a full season of dance will incur the following payments on a schedule that is set by CSDS. Details on Page 5.

- Semester Tuition, 3 payments (Fall, Winter, Spring)
- Advance Costume Payment, (1 costume per class enrolled. Due in January)
- Recital Performance Fee (One-time annual fee per family, due in May)
- Dancers in the CSDS Company will incur additional competition entry & costume fees. Detailed in the CSDS Company handout.
- Recital Show Ticket purchases, \$20 General admission. Kids under 3, free.

Recital Week & Recital Day

It is annual tradition to present CSDS' recital performance each June. Each weekly class that appears on the schedule will perform a routine in the show with the exception of Pre-Pointe/Beginner Pointe. Faculty & students will prepare choreography during regular class time in February/March. After 10 weeks of Spring semester, we enter Recital week. This includes 3 days of commitment:

- 1. Staging Rehearsal, In-Theater New this year!
- 2. Dress Rehearsal, In-Theater Includes full costume & makeup
- 3. Recital Day Performance & Grand Finale Bow Cast party to follow in June.
- Select Ballet classes may have a 4th day on their schedule for additional performance rehearsal. Each participating student in the recital will either purchase or rent one costume for each routine they appear in. **See next page.**

CSDS SEASON 27: TUITION & FEE POLICY

Paying Your Tuition

- Each Semester's tuition is due at the start of each new semester (September, December, March)
- CSDS Families will receive an email invoice when tuition is due.
- Please see Page 6 for all Tuition pricing & refund policies.

Tuition Discounts:

- Tuition is calculated by the total number of hours per week a combined CSDS family attends class. Class volume discounts apply to families dancing 4 or more hours per week.
- To request an alternative payment schedule, please speak with Jeannie or Christina. We work to make payment plans to any family seeking this kind of support to maintain their child's dance education.
- CSDS offers the option to pay for the full dance season up front and receive an additional 5% "full-year" discount off your total semester tuition. Please inform the front desk to take advantage of this traditional offer.

Recital Performance Fees

Recital Performance Fees are a one-time fee that is designed to offset
the high production costs of "Recital Week" practices and professionally
staffed theater rehearsals. The CSDS Team along with professional
production assistants work full-time to keep your dancer well-cared for
during this exciting week. Annual Recital Fees are separate from tuition
payments and no longer include a "Recital Semester" tuition charge.
Recital Fees are determined by the number of routines per family
performing in the recital, due on May 1, 2024.

*Single class students: \$60 per dancer / *2-3 routines: \$120 per family *4-6 routines: \$150 per family / *7 or more routines: \$175 per family

Recital Costume Purchase:

Each participating student performing in the recital will purchase or rent one costume for each routine in which they are appearing. Costumes will be custom-sized and ordered from professional costuming agencies in the Winter. All CSDS dancers will have a costume fitting during class time in May 2024. Purchased costumes belong to you unless there is a rental agreement noted. To ensure on-time order & delivery, all costume payments will be billed in November and are due in January 2024. \$75 (Ages 3-6, Children's Program) PER COSTUME \$85 (Age 7-10, Levels 1 - 4) \$90 (Level 5, 6 & Teen Classes) PER COSTUME \$100 (Company & Advanced classes)

- CSDS communicates regular with its families via email.
- Most announcements are posted regularly on our social media.
- Each Semester, a Newsletter will be handed out to all dancers and posted on our website.
- Remember to check dance bags for paper invoices, forgotten papers, and please refer to the lobby bulletin board in studio.

Class Attendance

In case of absences, please call or email in advance whenever possible. Please refrain from texting your dance teachers about absences unless there is a reason you cannot reach the studio. When absent, students may take a comparable makeup class. Please call the office to arrange all makeup classes.

Weather Cancellations

Any cancellation or schedule change for a class due to inclement weather will be shared in in the following ways by 1pm on the day of:

- Email from CSDS, Studio Voicemail, Website, and Social Media.
- If a class has allotted snow days built in to the schedule, a makeup class will not be scheduled. However, if a class must be made up, it will be scheduled after inclement weather has passed.

Classroom Etiquette, High Expectations

The CSDS Faculty is invested in managing the classroom in positive and effective ways. This includes a kind, empathetic approach, clear instructions, expectations, and offering students feedback & corrections during class. Students & teachers should always greet each other at the start of class and take the opportunity to say thank you before leaving. Ballet students often take an individual curtsey to their instructors before exiting the classroom. All CSDS members are asked to adhere to dress code and demonstrate the utmost respect to their peers & instructors.

Food & Drink Policy

• All students should bring plenty of water to class each day. CSDS will occasionally have bottled spring water available to purchase at the desk for \$1, or complimentary bottles in the studio. We will always provide cups for water at the bathroom sink. Please do not eat or open snacks in the classroom. Snacks are permitted in the waiting room or student lounge during breaks or between classes.

CSDS SEASON 27: STUDIO PROTOCOL

Arriving to Class

- All dancers should enter through the waiting room (Farwell Ave, downstairs entrance). Please wait in the waiting room until called to class.
- Do your best to arrive 10 minutes before your class time. This ensures that students are ready to dance at the start of class, and gives students the chance to socialize *before* class begins.

Downtime at the Studio

- CSDS is equipped with a small student library and comfortable seating for students to read, draw, or do homework during any downtime they have at the studio.
- It is perfectly acceptable for a student to be dropped off early or wait after class for pickup. They will be supervised and safe waiting in the waiting room until their class begins.
- Students with multiple classes in a day or with a break between their classes may use the CSDS student lounge when available.

Dismissal & Pickup

- All students will be dismissed from CSDS' personal entryway on FARWELL AVE (the hillside of CSDS).
- Please expect your child to be outside of the studio & ready for pickup about 5 minutes after their official class end time.
- Dance class ends at the time listed on the class schedule. Students are then permitted pack their belongings & head out.
- CSDS understands the challenges of parking around the Green St. area. If a parent is not visibly present for pickup, we will escort young children up & down the hill to help find their person. If you do not see your dancer outside, please park and come in the studio to pick them up.

Refund & Account Credit Policies

- Tuition payments are non-refundable in the case of missed or dropped classes. It is CSDS policy to encourage dancers to attend a comparable makeup class when they have been absent, or switch to a new class.
- In the case of a prolonged injury, illness, or relocation, CSDS will issue a partial credit to your account, or a pro-prated refund in some cases.
- If you have paid for the year-in-full, but any of the above situations arise during Semester 1, CSDS will issue 50% of the initial tuition payment.

 After Semester I, no tuition refunds/credits will be issued.

CSDS SEASON 27: STUDIO PROTOCOL

When to Stay Home / When to Observe Class

- If a student displays consistent cold-like symptoms/cough, we ask they stay home and attend a makeup class when feeling better.
- If a student is feeling under the weather for reasons other than cold/illness (such as fatigue or menstruation) please come to to the studio to relax & observe class in-person.
- If your child was recently in class and then is home due to a Covid exposure or has tested positive for Covid, please let our office know so that we may consider the timeline & take next steps when necessary.
- Faculty & Students alike may choose to wear a mask when they deem necessary or if we agree it is in the best interest of everyone present.
- CSDS honors parent discretion & family privacy. Please reach out to us if you wish to discuss any of these policies in more detail or have a health issue that you would like us to be aware of.

Photos & Media Publicity

Speaking from a modern day parent's point of view, we understand the complexities around our children being photographed in school or during activities and where those photos may appear later. Please note the following policies & considerations regarding photo & video @ CSDS:

- Most photo moments at CSDS are captured directly by Miss Christina. Sometimes this is during class to highlight an achievement or birthday.
- Sometimes, but not always, these photos will be shared on our social media pages or in CSDS publicity materials. In the case of birthdays, we will try out best to send a copy of the photo to your family via email.
- CSDS respects the privacy of every member of the studio and we do
 not overshare. We thank you for trusting us, however if you do not
 want your child to appear in any photographs, please note your
 preferences on the Fall enrollment form and confirm your request in
 person at the front desk in September.

Dress Code & Appearance

- To respect the traditions of all dance styles in an authentic way, all students must adhere to the specific dress code outlined for their class.

Thank you for respecting and adhering to the CSDS dress code to the best of your ability. Our combined efforts contribute to a respectable and authentic dance environment!

What to do if you are unable to meet Dress Code:

We understand that 'life happens' and you may not always be able to find the correct tights or leotard on a given dance day! Here are some solutions to help ease your concerns & stress at home when getting ready for class:

- You may wear an alternative color tights than usually required. Please inform your instructor that you couldn't find you regular tights today.
- CSDS has a limited, gently-used dance wear collection for these occasions. We are happy to lend you something to borrow but can't guarantee a perfect fit. If this is the case, please instruct your child to speak to the Front Desk upon arrival. Student are asked to take their borrowed items home to wash & return at their next class.
- Helpful hair supplies are always stocked & available in the CSDS bathroom. If you are planning to do your hair at the studio, please take the time to use the mirror and supplies provided for a strong appearance.
- If you need help with your ballet bun, please speak to a CSDS staff and we will do our best to assist you as long as it is not during class time.
